
Our downtown library receives over **1 million visits each year** from Edmontonians of all backgrounds and with a wide variety of interests.

- From students studying for their next exam, to marginalized Edmontonians getting assistance finding shelter or ID.






MORE Space for the Services Our Customers Need and Want!

Renewal Plans Include:




More opportunities for creating with leading-edge and emerging technologies like 3-D printing, sound and video production, and robotics, as well as new opportunities for fabrication. New spaces for creative activities like music and art will also be added.



An enlarged Children's Library with hands-on STEM (science, technology, engineering and math) activities like coding, robotics and digital creation, an indoor play area, more great resources to take out and enjoy, and more opportunities for parents, caregivers and children to connect, learn and grow.



Additional private study spaces and quiet reading areas including over 1,000 square feet overlooking Churchill Square.




A proposed demonstration kitchen to help Edmontonians better understand health, nutrition and food preparation.



Additional meeting spaces, including a community board room, supporting the growing need for community collaboration and accessible meeting spaces.



Embedded partners – space for agencies and organizations that provide complementary services to share service area in our well-used public space.



A high-tech theatre supporting renowned guest speakers and performances, with easy access to the LRT and Churchill Square.



A multi-story interactive simulation wall facilitating hands-on, interactive learning as well as large-scale multimedia presentations.

With community support, EPL will transform the downtown library in the next three to four years to better meet the growing and changing needs of Edmontonians. We will create purposeful spaces to collaborate, learn, access technology and attend events, as well as better connect to the outdoor space by Churchill Square on the north and Centennial Plaza on the south.



“**Space** to run around and burn that energy, and **quiet places** to sit and read.”


