### 3D Printing Club for Kids

Want to cruise down Edmonton's streets with a 100% personalized name plate for your bike? How about making a palm sized model of your dream house? Maybe you're interested in mars bases, game tokens, or a trophy to tell the world how awesome you are... the sky is the limit with 3D printing! In this class, EPL staff will guide you through designing a 3D printable model in TinkerCAD –we'll learn what works and what doesn't when designing for the 3D printing process and work on a project. EPL will 3D print each participant's design for free, making it available for pick up at your local branch. Mouse skills are strongly recommended for this class.

### Preschool Problem Solvers (6 Weeks)

### Bissell Centre Housing Workshop

Experiencing houselessness or possibly facing it? Looking for stable long term housing? Meet with Bissell Centre's Housing Navigators at a drop in housing workshop – no appointment required. They can help you:

- Check on your situation with Homeward Trust and let you know what supports you are eligible to access
- Search and contact affordable housing options
- Know the laws and rights around being a tenant
- Connect with other useful resources and programs

**Teen to Adult. NOTE: Bissell Centre Housing Workshops cannot provide immediate shelter, emergency housing, or crisis response. The focus is long-term stability and sustainability.**

### Family Centre Drop-In Counselling

Professional private and confidential counselling offered to individuals, couples/partners and families with a therapist from The Family Centre. Single sessions take up to 50 minutes and are offered on a first-come, first-serve basis, so please be prepared to wait or be referred to another location.

### Cricut 101

In this introductory class, learn the process for making a simple project on the Cricut. You'll learn the basics of creating designs, how to use the library's Cricut Maker, and how to assemble your project.
