Family Centre Drop-In Counselling

Professional private and confidential counselling offered to individuals, couples/partners and families with a therapist from The Family Centre. Single sessions take up to 50 minutes and are offered on a first-come, first-serve basis, so please be prepared to wait or be referred to another location.

Financial Literacy: The Journey Out Of Debt

Computer Skills: Introduction to using email

You should already know basic computer parts and terms, how to use a mouse, how to type, how to launch a program in Microsoft Windows and how to navigate an internet browser.

A laptop and mouse will be provided for this class. You may need a mobile phone in this class for verification upon email set up. The mobile phone is recommended but not required.

Computer Skills: Smartphones and Tablets

This is a class for those who are new to tablets and smartphones or are looking to become more confident using these devices, including English language learners and seniors. You will learn the basic differences between Apple and Android, how to navigate your device, what the different icons mean, how to find and adjust your settings, and what apps are and how to access them. No prior knowledge is required.

Tablets will be provided. Bring your own device (smartphone and/or tablet) if you have one!
