Family Centre Drop-In Counselling

Professional private and confidential counselling offered to individuals, couples/partners and families with a therapist from The Family Centre. Single sessions take up to 50 minutes and are offered on a first-come, first-serve basis, so please be prepared to wait or be referred to another location.

Tech Time

Need some one-on-one tech help? Bring your device (or use one of ours) and come prepared with a tech-related question or challenge you would like to explore with a savvy staff member.

Tech Time is divided into three 20-minute timeslots that you can sign up for upon arrival. If you do not get a timeslot, you may put your name down on a waiting list in case we are ahead of schedule.

Some common topics are Microsoft Office programs, mobile device troubleshooting, setting up and navigating a new device, accessing e-books and other online library resources, creating a social media account, adjusting device settings, transferring files between devices, and managing files or photos.

We are unfortunately not qualified to fix a damaged device or replace components.

We also offer a series of beginner computer classes, called "Computer Skills," which are best for those without basic knowledge or who want to explore an entire topic rather than a specific question.

Computer Skills: Introduction to Using Computers

This is a class for those who are new to computers including English language learners and seniors. You will learn about the types of computers, what computer parts are called, and how to use a mouse and keyboard. No prior knowledge is required. A laptop and mouse will be provided for this class.

Computer Skills: Introduction to the Windows Desktop

This is a class for those who are new to computers including English language learners and seniors. You will learn how to navigate a Windows desktop and file system as well as common Windows programs for everyday tasks. You should already know basic computer parts and terms, and how to use a mouse and keyboard. A laptop will be provided for this class.

Computer Skills: Introduction to Typing and Microsoft Word

This is a class for those who are new to computers including English language learners and seniors. You will learn typing basics, how to use Microsoft Word documents and basic formatting techniques. You should already know basic computer parts and terms, how to use a mouse, and how to launch a program in Microsoft Windows. A laptop and mouse will be provided for this class. **NOTE: Registration required**

Computer Skills: Introduction to Browsing and Searching the Internet

This is a class for those who are new to computers including English language learners and seniors. You will learn about what the internet is, how to use a web browser, and how to browse and search the internet. You should already know basic computer parts and terms, how to use a mouse and keyboard, and how to navigate Microsoft Windows. A laptop and mouse will be provided for this class. **NOTE: Registration required**
