### VOCABULARY CLUB: English Conversation Class

Join our fun English vocabulary and conversation class at the library! This program is perfect for people who are just starting to learn English. In this class, you'll discover everyday English words and how to use them. You'll practice using these words in conversations and other activities. We'll mainly focus on building your vocabulary, improving your speaking skills, and doing some simple reading.

### Cricut 101: Certification

This class enables customers to book appointments on Cricut machines at select EPL branches. Completing this class will certify all participants over the age of 12 to book Cricut machines and vinyl cutters at EPL. Customers under 12 must be accompanied by a caregiver who is certified during Cricut bookings. You should already know basic computer parts and terms, how to use a mouse, and how to launch a program in Microsoft Windows. ### Computer Skills: Introduction to Microsoft Excel

This is a class for those who are new to computers including English language learners and seniors. You will learn what Excel is and what it can be used to do, how to enter, edit and format data in a spreadsheet and an introduction to constructing basic formulas. You should already know basic computer parts and terms, how to use a mouse and keyboard, and how to navigate Microsoft Windows. A laptop and mouse will be provided for this class.
