Conversation Circle with Leif Gregersen

Join our circle for a conversation around various topics surrounding mental health and isolation in Edmonton. This is an opportunity for members of the community to engage in meaningful conversation with local experts and to share their personal experiences with each other. The conversation circle format will allow for a two-way sharing of information and the generation of ideas that have the potential to facilitate positive change.

Leif Gregersen, born and raised in the Edmonton area, is a public speaker, writer and poet whose main focus is in fighting the stigma and myths surrounding mental illness through his writing and public talks. Leif was diagnosed with an illness which combines symptoms of bipolar disorder and schizophrenia, known as schizoaffective disorder, as a teenager still living with his parents and has undergone a long journey back to acceptance and good mental health. Leif has been recognized with awards for his dedication to the McCauley community, won four writing awards in 2016 alone, and was voted as one of the top 11 Canadian "Writers to Watch" on the CBC Canada Writes website.

Join Leif as he speaks and shares from his own experience and promotes a conversation about mental illness and isolation and its effects on our modern society as well as on those who continue to suffer.

Light refreshments will be served. Seating is limited. Registration is appreciated but not required. This program is organized by the City of Edmonton Urban Isolation and Mental Health Initiative in partnership with Edmonton Public Library and will be held bi-monthly throughout 2017.
