Baby Laptime

Enjoy delightful stories, songs, books, rhymes, finger plays and more, especially for babies. Cuddle with your baby and connect with other caregivers. Duration: 30 minutes. **Ages 0 - 12 months. NOTE: Registration recommended**

Baby Social Time

Drop in for social time with other families and their babies! Come relax in a comfortable space where your baby can play and you can connect with other parents and caregivers. No structured programming is provided. Duration: 90 minutes. **Ages 0 - 12 months.**

Sing, Sign, Laugh and Learn

You and your child from birth to age three are invited to join us for songs, rhymes and signs! In this inclusive class, offered in collaboration with the Edmonton Early Intervention Program, parents/caregivers will interact one-on-one with their child while learning strategies to engage their child and enhance their child's communication and development through repetition, visuals and movement. Duration: 45 minutes. **Ages 0 - 3. NOTE: Registration recommended**

Adapted Storytime

Children 2-5 years old and their families are invited to this sensory-friendly storytime featuring interactive songs and rhymes, engaging stories and sensory-supportive tools! Children are welcome to bring their own blanket, stuffie, or fidget toys, and to participate in whatever way works best for them. Participation is limited to 8 families and while it's designed to work well for neurodiverse kids, everyone is welcome. Duration: 30 minutes. **Ages 2 - 5. NOTE: Registration recommended**

Preschool Problem Solvers (5 Weeks)

Looking for opportunities that help build school skills and encourage independence? Preschool Problem Solvers introduces shapes, numbers, colours and classroom behaviour to children aged four to five. In this class, they will dance, sing, investigate and have fun! Parents may choose to participate or let their child attend solo. All parents must remain in the library for the duration of the class. Duration: 45 minutes. This class has a limit of 15 participants. **Ages 4 - 5. NOTE: Registration required. This program is created for preschool children ages 4-5. Grown-ups and siblings are welcome to watch, but the activities are designed especially for our preschool friends.**
